<b>VOLUNTEER CLASSIFICATIONS</b>	Page 1 of 2	12/18/08

PURPOSE:

To provide a uniform guideline for different levels (involvement) of Volunteers in the Clay County Fire Rescue Department

A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS:

1. Must be 18 years of age or older.
2. Have a High School diploma or G.E.D.
3. Possess a valid Florida Driver's license with good driving record.
4. Complete a physical as outlined in the Departments Physical Policy.
5. Must attend Department and Division required trainings as stated in policy.
6. Submit a completed Volunteer Firefighter application
7. Live in Clay County
8. EVOC and driver trained on what they will operate before they can drive.

B. **CLASS 1 Combat Firefighter**: Able to perform interior fire attack and all other functions and duties assigned to the Volunteer Division.

1. Must be trained to the Firefighter 1 or greater standard and have S-130 and S-190.
2. Shall be issued full bunker gear, SCBA mask, yellow Volunteer Helmet Wildland PPE, and T-Shirt, Uniform shirt and pants

C. **CLASS 2 Support Firefighter**: Can perform exterior work such as but not limited to the following:

1. Does not have to be Firefighter 1 trained but does need to be First Responder trained or greater, trained to Department standards for position. Pump Operations – if qualified
2. All exterior work that is not in an IDLH atmosphere
3. REHAB
4. Customer service – After fire type work with owner of structure
5. Public Service events and education
6. Shall be issued bunker gear, NO SCBA Mask, a Yellow Hard Hat, T-Shirt, Uniform shirt and pants

D. **Class 3 EMS Support Volunteer:** Will be able to perform EMS support functions Can perform work such as but not limited to the following:

1. Must have CPR training and within 1 year have First Responder training
2. Can only ride on any CCFR unit and perform EMS to level of their training under supervision of the officer in charge
3. Can provide REHAB at fire scenes
4. Customer Service
5. Public Service events and education
6. Will not be issued bunker gear but will be issued a Blue Hard Hat, T-shirts, Uniform shirt and pants
7. Can be new volunteers without FF1 training

E. **Class 4 CUSTOMER SERVICE VOLUNTEER: Will give customer support to internal and external customers.**

1. REHAB
2. Help staff the Customer Service Unit
3. Will assist at large incidents with food, drink, etc.
4. Public Service Events and Education
5. Must have CPR training and within 1 year have First Responder training
6. Will not issued bunker gear
7. Will be issued T-shirt, Uniform Shirt, pants and a blue hard hat with Customer Service on each side of hat
8. Can be new volunteers without FF1 training
