Rescinds 910

Purpose: Specify medical standards for volunteer firefighter status to be compliant with Federal and State requirements.

Scope: Fire Rescue Division of the Clay County (hereinafter known as the "Department") shall maintain Firefighter Classification Policy applicable to its volunteer members in accordance with the standards that are included in the Department's policies on Physicals.

Personnel: The employer shall assure that employees who are expected to do interior structural firefighting are physically capable of performing duties which may be assigned to them during emergencies.

Persons should not be assigned to tasks requiring use of respirators unless it has been determined that they are physically able to do the work and use the equipment as per Department policies.

I. MEDICAL AUTHORITY AND SELECTION as per the Department's policies on Physicals.

II. CLASSIFICATION OF FIREFIGHTERS

1. INTERIOR FIREFIGHTER

Shall be trained to the Firefighter 1 level as required by the State of Florida and in accordance with Florida Administrative Code Chapter 69A-62.003(4)(a).

2. EXTERIOR FIREFIGHTER (NON-SCBA)

Shall be all other Volunteers that do not meet the above section and in accordance with Florida Administrative Code Chapter 69A-62.003(4)(b).

III. PERIODIC PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS - As per the Department's policies on Physicals.

IV. RETURN-TO-DUTY MEDICAL EVALUATIONS - As per the Department's policies on Physicals
